### **BUILDING PROJECT UPDATE**



With gratitude for our generous donors, architect Sam Fitzgerald, and the whole team at BD, the Building Committee is pleased to report on the ongoing renovations of both the Chapel and the Parsonage.

Over the last eighteen months in the church, we have removed asbestos tiles, shored up and then leveled the concrete slab beneath the floors, installed new flooring, painted the sanctuary, upgraded the HVAC system, and completely renovated the kitchen. In progress now is the creation of a new entrance vestibule with glass doors across from the Ferguson window, increasing a sense of arrival and welcome. In the coming months, we will remodel the Fellowship Hall with a large window and window seat, and install a handsome room divider to separate the Sanctuary and Fellowship Hall when desired. All of this work is intended to better support our church and community ministries.

Around the corner from the church, the Parsonage is also getting spruced up, with a new kitchen; a new bathroom upstairs that creates a primary suite; and a new laundry room in the basement. A new staircase with appropriate treads and a mudroom/vestibule are planned for the summer or fall. We are grateful to the Vestry of St. John's for currently renting its Rectory to Union Chapel as a home for the Andersons during the Parsonage renovation.

All of this work has to date been made possible by early, generous gifts from donors who recognize the importance of Union Chapel to the spiritual and relational health of the island community, particularly the year-round population. Our initial budget of \$630,000 has risen to \$750,000 due in equal parts to inflation and increased scope. To date we have raised just over \$500,000 and hope to secure commitments for the final \$250,000 by June 30, 2023. We invite gifts of every size and welcome pledges paid over two years. #### WHAT'S AHEAD IN 2023

At Union Chapel's Annual Meeting on January 22nd, the congregation approved a balanced budget for 2023 with a new line item! The Trustees have approved the development of a Media Lab that will become the foundation for youth ministry and a resource for the island. The idea is to create an environment for young people to work with adults to develop skills in new media and to gain confidence with these modes of communication to create messages to promote peace, environmental sustainability, religious discovery, and interfaith understanding. In his letter of support for the project, Dylan Gauthier, Program Director at Lighthouse Works, wrote, "Organized by Pastor Rosanna and her husband Clifford, I am certain that this lab will become a vital resource for the island on the whole, as well as a vibrant space for learning, creativity, and experimentation at the heart of Union Chapel. I can think of almost nothing more exciting and stimulating for the island's youth, and think it would be a great asset to the broader community." We agree! Look for the lab to take shape in the coming weeks and if you would like to volunteer to help, please let Pastor Rosanna know.

The budget projects continued strong revenue from the Thrift Shop (thank you, volunteers and shoppers), the Fishers Island Churches Golf Classic (another round of thanks to those volunteers and supporters) and annual appeal revenue of \$125,000, a 25% increase from 2022, but a return to 2020 levels. We will send our appeal letter out after Easter and welcome gifts at any time mailed to P.O. Box 192, Fishers Island, NY 06390. Thank you so much for your generous support.

Together we look forward to a Spirit-filled year, with the building project continuing to transform the experience of our building, the new Media Lab taking shape, and islanders of all seasons feeling increasingly connected to and welcomed at Union Chapel.
