
present and work with us. When we respond, the Lord lightens our load and helps us go forward with hope, renewed energy and strength.


SENIOR LUNCH

FALL CLASSES AT THE MEDIA LAB FOR GOOD

Friday, September 29 6:30 - 7:30 pm

Introduction to the Media Lab (Clifford Anderson)

This workshop will provide an orientation to the Media Lab for Good, covering the use of the camera, microphone, lighting, and podcasting equipment along with basic post-production utilities.

Friday, October 20 6:30 - 7:30 pm

Introduction to DaVinci Resolve (Clifford Anderson)

This workshop will introduce time-based editing using DaVinci Resolve 18. In this workshop, you will learn to compose video clips on a timeline, create simple graphic effects, and adjust sound levels to produce high-quality videos.

Friday, November 17 6:30 - 7:30 pm

Introduction to Podcasting (Clifford Anderson)

In this workshop, you will learn how to record and edit high-quality podcasts using the Rode RODECaster Pro II Studio along with Audacity open source audio editing software.
