

LENTEN BIBLE STUDY

Would you like to draw closer to God this winter? Join us on Wednesday mornings during Lent, the six weeks of preparation that lead up to the celebration of Easter. We will meet in the newly redecorated Parlor and via Zoom on Wednesday mornings from 9:00 - 10:00 a.m.

We will talk about *Living into Lent* by Donald K. McKim (Westminster John Knox Press, 2020). This thoughtful book will help us to reflect on our Christian identity, listen to God's Word and will, and engage in practices that deepen our experience of faith through discipleship. Author Don McKim is a renowned theologian and professor who relates the Bible passage to daily life. Each reading features Scripture, devotion, a theological quotation, response, and prayer.

If you have spent time at Union Chapel lately, you will have seen (and smelled!) a lot of fresh paint. Our building project continues to transform the chapel and there is more to come this winter and spring, including glass doors and a new large window and window seat in the Fellowship Hall, plus a new divider for separating the hall and the sanctuary. Over at the Parsonage, a basement room is becoming a finished laundry room, and we will add a new entrance vestibule at the front of the house this spring.

None of this would be possible without your generosity. Thank you! In October, we announced an \$80,000 matching challenge to finish up the fundraising for the building project. The response has been wonderful. I am delighted to report that through the generosity of so many, we have met the \$80,000 challenge and reached our \$825,000 goal for the renovation of the chapel and the parsonage. Thanks be to God, and thank you to everyone who made gifts! We appreciate your continued support of Union Chapel and its ministries both on and off Fishers Island.

As the Trustees plan for 2024, we are excited to put our renovated building to good use as an island resource by increasing our community programs. FISHERS ISLAND SCHOOL ENJOYS THE MEDIA LAB FOR GOOD

Fishers Island School 10th and 11th grade English students headed to the Union Chapel Media Lab for Good this fall to learn about recording and editing audio and video for their class projects. With the help of Pastor Rosanna and her husband Clifford Anderson, students learned about using the camera, lights, microphones, and green screen as well as the audio recording equipment and software.

While reading Khaled Hosseini's *The Kite Runner*, 10th grade students spent several English class sessions creating a podcast centered around the immigration experience in the United States. Students were asked to consider both the positive and negative experiences of people who have left their home countries and come to America, just like two of the characters in Hosseini's novel. As the main part of their podcast project, students interviewed two island residents, Marlin Bloethe and Claudia Desimone, about their own immigration experiences to better understand how such a life change can impact a person and the people around them.

From there, the sophomores spent time editing their interviews, recording their scripted material, adding in musical interludes and sound effects, and reviewing and finalizing their podcasts. The skills they have developed from utilizing the equipment at the Media Lab for Good will extend beyond any class project and will allow them the opportunity to record other podcasts, music, and films – really anything their imaginations can come up with!
