#### A Community Celebration on June 15: Pastor Rosanna's Installation Service

On Sunday, June 15, at 10:00 a.m., Union Chapel and the New London Association of the United Church of Christ will hold a worship service that will include the Installation of the Rev. Dr. Rosanna Anderson as our Settled Pastor. Union Chapel welcomes the entire Fishers Island community to join us for this milestone event.

Pastor Rosanna moved to Fishers Island in December 2021 to serve a three-year appointment as "Designated Term Pastor." Last fall, a Discernment Committee composed of leaders in the congregation, with input from more than thirty members and friends of Union Chapel, looked back with gratitude on all that the Chapel accomplished in those three years, noting how effectively Pastor Rosanna has nurtured our growth in faith and vitality, provided pastoral care during difficult times, and worked to built our



programmatic life, from Bible study to the media lab to the board game cafe, and to be a visible presence outside the church, developing relationships throughout the community. The committee was also enthusiastic about the contributions of Pastor Rosanna's family – her husband Dr. Clifford Anderson, the director of the Divinity School Library at Yale University, and their son Theodore, who is completing ninth grade at the Fishers Island School. In February, the congregation voted unanimously to call Pastor Rosanna to the role of Settled Pastor.

The Installation on June 15 will feature the Rev. Isaac Lawson, Area Conference Minister for the South Central region of the United Church of Christ, as Guest Preacher, and Chris Geist as guest organist. All of the island churches have been invited to participate in the service as have other island organizations. A festive reception will follow in the courtyard.

For those who cannot attend in person, Wes Walters will stream the service through Union Chapel's website, <u>fiunionchapel.org.</u> We hope that you will join us in person or online as we celebrate and give thanks to God for guiding us to this joyful season in the life of our community.

We look forward to welcoming the Rev. Isaac Lawson as the Guest Preacher on June 15. Rev. Lawson is our Area Conference Minister in the Southern New England Conference of the United Church of Christ. He has served in this role working with pastoral transitions and committees on church and ministry for the past four years. Having discerned a call to return to local church ministry, he will conclude this role at the end of June and begin a new chapter of his ministry in a different conference. We are grateful that he will preach the sermon at this special worship service.


Board Game Café Sundays June 29, July 27 and August 17 from 5:00 - 6:30 p.m.

#### **BUILDING PROJECT UPDATE**

When Union Chapel decided to remove asbestos floor tiles back in the spring of 2021, we had no idea that we were beginning a four-year project to completely renovate our building and make substantial upgrades to our Parsonage. But here we are, about to enter the final phase of work, which is scheduled to begin in June.

We have accomplished so much! New flooring and a shored up concrete slab underpin so many transformed spaces at the church – the Media Lab, the Parlor, the brand-new kitchen, the light-filled Fellowship Hall and the handsome new entry through the mahogany and glass double doors.

This summer we will complete the project with the installation of a big picture window in Fellowship Hall, a wooden divider to separate the church from the hall, and new ceiling plaster that will absorb sound when the hall is filled with people chatting. Stop in and watch the magic happen!

Generous donations have made all of this and the work at our Parsonage (new kitchen, new bathroom, and a reclaimed basement) possible. Although we had hoped to have concluded our fundraising, we are not quite done yet for all the usual reasons – inflation and rising costs, increased scope when we saw opportunities to improve the building that we hadn't previously planned, and the discovery that our 60-year-old building would need more shoring up than we expected.

This spring we set out to raise \$300,000, and already a number of wonderful donors have stepped up to help. We invite you to join them to make this project a community-wide effort. Whether you have worshiped on a Sunday morning, attended a funeral, enjoyed Senior Lunches or a Board Game Café, you know that the Union Chapel welcomes all.
